



TRAINING PASTORS TO SERVE THE CHURCH IN RUSSIA \$100,000



With this grant, Lutheran Women's Missionary League will partner in training pastors and deaconesses and in helping the seminary continue its efforts to restore the Lutheran Church in Russia. The Novosibirsk seminary's goal is to prepare workers to spread the true Word of God to the Russian people. This grant allow the seminary to continue providing a solid theological education to those seeking to serve as pastors and deaconesses within the Siberian Lutheran Church.

The Lutheran Theological Seminary in Novosibirsk, Siberia, is housed in a former bank building. The seminary is located on the second floor of this building, and the Parish of St. Andrew is situated on the first floor. St. Andrew is the parish in which Bishop Vsevolod Lytkin of the Siberian Evangelical Lutheran Church serves. The Siberian Lutheran Church is in full altar and pulpit fellowship with The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod.
